

UNIFORM POLICY & EXPECTATIONS

The uniforms you will be wearing were purchased new in 2020. It's imperative that uniforms be taken care of properly. Uniforms damaged due to poor student care will be replaced by the student.

The marching band uniform consists of 6 pieces:

Prices listed are based on replacement costs as of 7/01/2020. Prices are subject to change.

Plumes are distributed before every performance and returned immediately after.

- Garment Bag, \$12
- Jacket, \$245
- Bibbers, \$99
- Shako, \$53
- Plume, \$19
- Raincoats, \$70

The Color Guard Uniform consists of 3 pieces:

Prices listed are based on replacements costs as of 5/20/19. Prices are subject to change.

- Garment Bag, \$12
- Top, \$70
- Raincoat, \$70

Storing of Uniforms

- Uniforms are stored in garment bags at all times when not in use.
- Shakos should be stored in the correct shako box when not in use.
- Plumes are to be returned after every use.
- Uniforms are to be hung neatly on two hangers. The studier hanger for jackets, the wire hanger for pants. Color guard uniforms are hung on the black velvet hangers.
- Uniforms will be inspected by the directors for proper hanging following every performance.

Under the Uniform

- When in uniform, show shirts should be worn under the jacket. This allows us all to take off our jackets to be a little cooler while also still looking uniform. If one student does not have their show shirt on, we may not take the jackets off.
- Acceptable attire under the uniform: T-Shirts, compression tops or bottoms, athletic shorts, leggings, long black socks
- *Unacceptable* attire: **JEANS!!**, hooded sweatshirts, brightly colored articles of clothing

Uniforms in the Stands

- When jackets are not being worn, they are to be stored in garment bags
- Be mindful of the foods you are eating and be careful not to stain any part of the uniform
- Be sure you are sitting on the seat covers when in uniform
